In addition, a further £143.39 was collected, after Thursday's performance, for "Bloodwise Bromsgrove," a charity fighting to beat blood cancer, which is close to the hearts of a number of our Year 3 parents. Thank you to all the parents, family and friends of Year 3 children who contributed to these very worthy causes.

Breakfast Club

I would like to inform parents of some changes we will be making to Breakfast Club, which will take effect immediately after the Easter holidays. There has been no price increase for Breakfast Club since it was first opened, which was before I became Head Teacher in 2006. Since then, as you can imagine, costs of staffing, food, etc. have increased considerably. In addition, regulations have become more rigorous regarding the serving of hot food, which has an impact on the responsibilities of staff. Therefore, we have decided that we will no longer offer hot breakfast options after Easter. This will allow us to keep the price the same and will allow the staff to concentrate on ensuring that the children are engaged, healthy and happy rather than on completing extensive documentation. Children will still be offered cereal, toast and fruit along with milk, water and hot drinks on colder mornings. I trust that you understand our reasons for this change but, should any parents wish to discuss this further, please do not hesitate to contact me.
