## YEAR 4 – SEVERN VALLEY RAILWAY VISIT

We have organised a visit to the The Severn Valley Railway on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2018 linking with the lessons the children had on World War 2. We hope it will help bring their learning to life when they get the opportunity to dress up and travel on a steam train just like the evacuee children did during the war time. During the day, we will stop off at different locations along the Severn Valley route to take part in activities organised by the Severn Valley Railway which include "War Time Kitchen and Rationing", "1940's Toys and Games" and "Anderson Shelter".

We are asking parents to ensure their child arrives in school at 8:50 on this day to ensure we leave school at 9am as the train will leave Kidderminster station at 9:45. We will return to school in time for the end of the school day. A packed lunch will be required and also a drink and a snack. We would like the children to dress up in World War 2 clothes.

If you would like your child to attend this educational visit a voluntary contribution of  $\pm 15.50$  will be required to help us cover the costs. We would like to take this opportunity to respectfully inform all parents that, should we not receive a high enough percentage of voluntary contributions, it may not be possible for us to go on the visit.
