Anglo Saxon and Viking Day

On Thursday 25th January, the children in Year 4 will be having a visitor into school who will be bringing their Anglo-Saxon and Viking topic to life. The children will be exploring Anglo-Saxon Village life in the morning and, in the afternoon, they will be learning about the Legend of Thor's Hammer. If the children would like to dress up as an Anglo-Saxon or Viking, they may. However, this is not compulsory and so they may wish to still come in their school uniform.

Year 4 English Grammar Groups

From the week commencing Monday 22nd January, when we are teaching English Grammar skills, we will be teaching the children in ability groups. This will help us to ensure that the grammatical skills we are teaching are at an appropriate level for the children. For independent writing tasks, the children will remain in their normal class group. We will be speaking to the children about this on Wednesday.

Please could we ask that parents do not park in the turning school or in front of the main entrance in Carnforth Road so that we can get the children off the coach safely. Children will need to come back into school briefly and then 4M will be dismissed from their outside classroom door at the front of school and 4J will be dismissed from the main entrance.
