Phonics:

*To recognise all phase 2 and phase 3 graphemes that have been taught.

*Revise reading and spelling of all phase 2 and phase 3 'Harder to Read and Spell Words' that have been taught.

*To read the 'Harder to Read and Spell' words: said, so, have, were, out, like, some, come, there, little, one, do, children, love

*Continue to read and write words and sentences using the graphemes taught and the HRSW that have been taught.

<u>Maths:</u>

*Recognise and compare all numbers to 10.

*Review the compositions of all numbers to 10.

*Know number bonds to 5 and some to 10 including subtraction facts.

*Find and make doubles to 10.

*Identify odd and even numbers.

*Count to 20 and beyond and recognise teens numbers.

*Identify 3D shapes in the environment.

Ideas for you to do at home with your child:

*Continue to reinforce phase 2 and 3 graphemes and HRSW your child is unsure of.

*Read with your child at least x4 a week.

*Encourage your child to count as far as they can and at least to 40.

*Plant seeds together, look after them and watch them grow over time.

*Look for signs of spring when you go out and about.
